Community Support Arrangements During COVID19 Medical Emergency

As we now know, older residents over 70 and anyone with underlying health conditions are required and encouraged to stay at home or 'self-isolate', and others simply can't get out anyway for different reasons. We are therefore coordinating a Community Group to do our best to provide help and support to those in need.

DO YOU NEED SUPPORT?: You may not need support at the moment but may need help in the future perhaps with picking up or getting essential food and toiletry supplies, posting letters, walking the dog, picking up prescriptions, or perhaps you may just want to talk to someone. **You can register now on the numbers and email listed below and let us know what you need help with, and even if you currently have someone that is helping, you can still register now to keep in touch or call us any time in the future in case you find you need help later.**

ARE YOU ABLE TO OFFER SUPPORT?: if you are able to help in any way during this medical emergency please let us know by emailing, phoning or texting your contact details so we can then get back to you with details of our Volunteer Guidance to ensure your safety and that of those you will be supporting, and check what you are able to do and when you can do it. Support Volunteers will be issued with an identify badge and if you have a current DBS check this will be very useful. We will be setting up a WhatsApp Group/Facebook page for volunteers for communication and support purposes.

COMMUNITY SERVICES AND FACILITIES: We are in the process of setting up a new Parish Council Facebook page which will be used specifically at the moment to deal with providing information on the current medical emergency and the position on monthly meetings and council facilities, eg public toilets and cemetery arrangements. In the meantime **we have listed overleaf the essential shops/supplies available** in North Somercotes. Others will be added to the Facebook page as soon as possible so if you want to be listed or to suggest a listing for this page, please send this to the Parish Clerk using the email below.

DATA PROTECTION: your details will be held confidentially but will be shared with selected volunteers and recipients so we can match people up. They will be deleted once the current medical emergency has passed, unless you wish them to be kept on record as we move on with developing the Emergency Resilience and Flood Plan for the community.
